Homemade Won Ton Soup

Ingredients

- 4 cups chicken broth
- 1/2 cup thinly sliced carrot
- 5 to 6 green onions, chopped (about 1/2 cup)
- 2 cups chopped Bok Choy (seperated ribs from greens)
- 1 can water chestnuts
- Several dashes sesame oil
- Cilantro leaves (optional)
- 1 6-oz. package frozen, peeled, cooked shrimp, thawed
- 1 Package frozen pork dumplings
- 1/2 cup sliced fresh mushrooms
- 1 leftover chicken breast, cooked, chopped

Directions

Bring Chicken Broth to boil, add carrots, Bok Choy Ribs, Onions, and water chestnuts. Cook until almost tender (approximate 20 minutes) Add dumplings. Add shrimp and chicken pieces. Then add mushrooms, bok choy greens, and Cilantro, add dashes of sesame oil, then serve. Doctor with pepper or soy sauce as wanted.
