Please try to keep to 4 bowlers to a lane – we try to keep all lanes even so that we can all

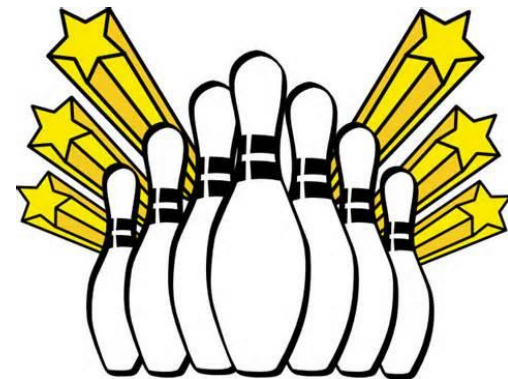
